

Notes:

These pages include spaces for postmarks listed in Friedemann and the ArGe Kolonien postmark catalog. Spaces are also included for Seepost and MSP postmarks that can be found on stamps of the colony.

There are certain postmarks, particularly Marine-Schiffspost postmarks, that are cataloged because the ship spent time in the colony, but are purely theoretical as no known copies exist on stamps of the colony. Pages are included for these for the sake of completeness, though they can easily be skipped or discarded if you don't want to include a page in your album that will likely never be filled.

As the postmarks are commonly found on stamps of different sizes and/or on piece, no stamp boxes are included. Rather, a large blank space is provided allowing for items of various sizes and quantities.

However, if you would like stamp boxes to match the style of those on the normal GermanStamps. net pages, or if you need any other customizations, please contact me through the "Contact Admin" form that's in the footer of every page on my website.

**NOTE ON PRINTING:** If, when printing, you have the option to print the pages actual size or shrink them to fit the paper, do not select shrink to fit! Doing so will shrink all content on the page. The pages should print correctly at actual size, regardless of any warnings your printer might give.

## German New Guinea Deutsch-Neuguinea

In the 1850s, German traders first established a foothold on the northern and eastern coasts of New Guinea, as well as on the surrounding smaller islands.

In May 1885, the German government entered into an agreement with the Neu Guinea Compagnie (New Guinea Company), under the terms of which the Company was authorized to acquire further lands as it saw fit. In return, the Company was to expand German influence within the area, and to build and maintain the local governmental institutions.




Flag of the German Colonial Office

On 1 April 1899, the German government formally took control


of the area formerly administered by the Neu Guinea Compagnie, as it had become cost prohibitive for the privately funded Company to develop and maintain the colony. An Imperial Governor was appointed to govern the colony, and in a reorganization of the German holdings in the South and Central Pacific, administration of the German colonies in the Carolines (1899), Marianas (1899), and Marshalls (1906) was eventually transferred to the Imperial Governor of German New Guinea.


German New Guinea was quickly conquered by Australian forces at the outbreak of WWI, and as with all of Germany's colonial possessions at the time, it was not returned to German control following the war. Instead, it became a League of Nations Protectorate under Australian control.
